NON-PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT NEGOTIATIONS AND RECUSAL (OFFICERS)

Senator Officers with a rate of pay at or above \$130,500 are required file this form with the Select Committee on Ethics (SH-220) **not later than three (3) business days** after the commencement of negotiations or entering into an arrangement for private employment. Senate Officers are also required to certify recusal from official action as required under Section 17 of the STOCK Act, Pub.L. 112-105 (Apr. 4, 2012). This form is **non-public**.

For your information, Section 17(b) of the STOCK Act states:

An individual filing a statement under subsection (a) shall recuse himself or herself whenever there is a conflict of interest, or appearance of a conflict of interest, for such individual with respect to the subject matter of the statement, and shall notify the individual's supervising ethics office of such recusal.
